

Introduction – The purpose of this note is to provide installation instructions and comments on a patch for the Pile Up Practice software. The patch applies to version 2.0.0 of the software and is provided to implement the enhancements and fix the problems described below.

Previous Patches – This is the second patch for version 2.0.0. If you have not installed version 2.0.0 and Patch 200-01 you should do so before installing Patch 200-02.

Installation – In addition to these notes the zip file associated with this patch contains a setup file for installing the patch in C:\ProgramFiles (x86)\CWSoft\PileUpPractice_200. Here's a list of the files contained in this patch and a description of where they will be installed. PileUpPractice is a 32-bit application.

File	Description
PileUpPractice.exe	The executable that runs the application. It will be located in the PileUpPractice_200 directory shown above.
PracticeSetupAndUse.pdf	Documentation on how to use the application. It will be located in the PileUpPractice_200 directory shown above

Problem/Enhancement	Status
Sorting should be retained across an open/closing of Practice History	Fixed
Sorting should be retained across an open/closing of Scores History	Fixed
Menu item Define new pileup does not seem to work	Fixed
Import does not work if there are no logs	Fixed
When importing a pileup or creating a new pileup it would be helpful to be able to set the intro skip time	Implemented
Ability to have the application randomly select an existing pileup would be helpful in avoiding memorizing the pileups	Implemented
It would be nice to be able to avoid the prompt regarding method of logging and skipping the intro. On the first response of the user there should be an option to remember these choices. This should be remembered across restarts of the program.	Implemented
When starting a pileup from Practice History the status on the main screen shows NONE started rather than the pileup name	Open
When a report is saved a restart is required in order for the View Reports menu to indicate the report is available	Open
